Dear Friends,

My time here has gone so quickly that I can't believe it's already November and we're thinking about Thanksgiving. Pluckemin is a joyous and gracious place in which to do ministry and I am grateful for the opportunity to grow in faith and discipleship with you.

As you know from the letter you received a few weeks ago, this is our stewardship season. Our theme is, "See, I am making all things new." The calling of a new Pastor is an opportunity for a fresh start in the life of a church and I sense that happening here. We are seeing new faces in worship, new infants in our nursery, and new children in children's church. Four new families who attended the October Discovery Class will be joining in the next few weeks. People in our community want to hear the gospel and serve those in need.

The officers seek to respond to these new opportunities as they plan for the 2011 budget. However, while Wall Street is recovering well, the rest of the economy continues to sputter along. Full recovery and employment is still on the distant horizon. How do we plan around that reality? The proposed budget for 2011 includes only a tiny overall increase over the current year. Increases are limited to programs that help us grow and to giving our non-ordained staff a small raise. (They did not receive a raise last year.) The programs that show slight increases are children, youth, and the website. Most of our visitors are families with children who are looking for a church in which they can all grow spiritually. We know that people in this demographic rely heavily on the internet in even choosing which church to visit. We want to showcase what I consider to be a great church with wonderful programs and service opportunities for all ages.

November 7 is Pledge Sunday. Please prayerfully consider what you are able to pledge for our Church's mission and ministry in 2011 and bring your pledge card to worship on the seventh. If you are not able to attend that Sunday, you may bring or mail your card to the church office.

May God continue to bless you.

The Great Prayer of Thanksgiving is the name of the prayer that we offer at the table each time we celebrate the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper. In this season of thanksgiving I believe it is good to reflect on the movement of this prayer. Once the table has been set we start out in dialogue. You know the beginning "the Lord be with you" and the answer is "And also with you." The prayer moves through this dialogue mentioning that as people of God we praise God for almighty acts of the past, present and future. This is done in the manner of Jewish blessings. We praise God for creating all things, for establishing covenant, for the law and we lift up acts of the prophets. Then we recognize God's boundless love and mercy.

Often at this point we sing or say the Sanctus. "Holy, holy, holy Lord" is the song of the choirs of angels sung eternally before God's majesty. Then we add the "Hosanna" the chants of praise that greeted Jesus' entry into Jerusalem.

As the great thanksgiving continues we speak of Jesus, his birth, ministry, his sacrifice and his resurrection. We continue to thank God as we explain Jesus' action on the night of his betrayal. We then joyfully acclaim the Christ who has died, is risen and will come again. We move to words about the Holy Spirit. We rejoice in the action of the Spirit in each of our lives. Here we add concerns of our own congregation and usually end with the Lord's Prayer. How beautifully it unfolds. Now you know.

Have you noticed our confirmands in church each Sunday? Did you know they are taking "notes?" Each week they fill out a worship report for class. It helps them to stay interested (I hope). And perhaps even to notice things that I do not see in the movement of worship. Though we are just at the beginning of our year we are making progress. I will let you know about their progress as we journey through the church year.
